1. The application is done fully <u>online</u>, please follow the instructions at each step of the application. You will be asked to submit the following documents via the online portal:

- Sec 3 EOY result slips and Sec 4 WA result slip (if available)
- CCA records & achievements that are related to your DSA talent area (limit to achievements from Sec 1 to Sec 4)
- Awards/scholarships that are evidence of your DSA talent area (limit to those from Sec 1 to Sec 4)
- Art Portfolio (for those applying for Art Elective Programme)

[You need to be selective as there is a cap of 128MB on the supporting document file size that you can upload. You are advised to submit the documents in a single file (pdf format).

2. The online submission of the application form including supporting documents must be done by 26 June 2023 (Monday), 12 noon.

We do not accept application via fax and electronic mail. Incomplete submission will **NOT** be considered.
